Message leaflet will be provided by HKCNP to donors for writing their blessings, then place inside the box. (HKCNP will check all the boxes and decorate them with wrapping paper.) 2. If you could not find boxes of the suggested size, you may use cardboard container of A4 paper. We will rearrange and fit them into suitable boxes after collection. 3. If you do not have any suitable boxes for the gift, all gifts can be stored in a large box. We will collect them and place them into suitable boxes. Please be reminded that the size of the gift should not be bigger than a shoe box.
