



4 BASIS STEPS OF FAITH

- **Stating the facts what the Bible says about the poor and what is expected from us**
James 2:5 God has chosen the poor to be rich in faith
- **Stating a clear set of Biblical values to become the core foundation of the ministry**
1John 4:19 We love because He first loved us.
- **Review regularly of process and execution, be a good shepherd**
Proverbs 3:6 In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your path straight.
- **Rewards**
Proverbs 19:17 Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the Lord, and he will reward them for what they have done



CHALLENGE THE CONGREGATION - PURITY IN MIND

- Serving the poor is a NOT an option, we love because He first loved us.
- We are blessed so that we can bless others.
- God doesn't need anyone of us but He wants us to see His glory.
- Look at the cross and His sacrifices for us.
- It's availability not ability. Don't limit our God.



VISION AND VALUE

Vision :- Burdened by the Spirit, Clarity and Continuity, Set direction only

Value :- Lay the foundation (meeting the needs, volunteers seeing the glory of God, preach the Gospels), Prevent falling into the trap of performing (labor in vain), Live a relationship of love and not duty (God doesn't need us)



PROGRAM VERSUS DISCIPLESHIP

- You can build a company program with professional leadership but you cannot build a church program without discipleship i.e. one on one relationship with people and willingness to invest in one another.
- Be a good shepherd. Pray with them, listen to them. 7/52 prayer covering.



SUSTAINABLE MINISTRY -ITS EASY TO START AND HARD TO MAINTAIN

- 1) must have a clear vision that is given by God
- 2) must have well defined values based on Biblical principles.
- 3) must be a prayerful ministry in all aspects
- 4) must not be performance based
- 5) must be a good shepherd
- 6) must give all glory to God
