Our vision: The "PeaceBox Campaign" hopes to spread blessings and love to those in need by encouraging the public to donate materials and gifts to grassroots communities. A small donation may seem insignificant, but together they create a collective power filled with care, willing to share, and bringing joy and hope.

Introduction

The city-wide "PeaceBox Campaign" has been held since 2014, promoting a message of love and care during Easter to allow people to feel compassion and happiness. This year, The Hong Kong Church Network for the Poor (HKCNP) is the main organizer of the event. Through HKCNP's Love in Action, donors are provided free resources to assist and encourage churches, organizations, NGOs, businesses and schools to send gifts on Easter, a day full of hope, and care for the physical, mental, social and spiritual needs of the community. Over the past 10 years, more than 110,000 PeaceBox gifts have been distributed. The number of people donating, receiving, and participating in PeaceBox continues to increase, with more than 400,000 participants.

The following are sharings from churches and beneficiaries that have participated in the PeaceBox Campaign in the past:

Sharing from HKCNP's partner church, HMCC: In my limited love, I have witnessed God's love and His faithfulness. Although my experience interacting with children is very limited, and the love I can give is also very limited, God still uses everything I have to glorify Him. When one of the children came over and asked me to carry him, I felt loved, which showed me that God's love also filled them. Praise God for everything He has done in the ministry, and I will continue to pray for you!

A Recipient: A grassroots mother who never speaks of her pain- she never talks to anyone about it because she would cry if she did. When the Church of Christ in China Tin King Church sent her a PeaceBox gift, they discovered that she had even more difficulties. Rev Lai provided her with more care and assistance, and the pastor felt that the women's vitality and joy had returned.
